

# CENTRUS ENERGY CORP.

## Site Access and Auction Requirements

### Inspection, Auction, or Material Pickup

All personnel interested in performing an inspection of material being offered for auction, attending the auction, and/or picking up purchased auction material must be a U.S. citizen. This includes any personnel contracted to pick up material, on your behalf, such as truck driver(s), riggers, etc.

Upon initial site visit, and prior to receiving site access, each person shall be required to present proof of U.S. citizenship (i.e. valid birth certificate with photo ID, or passport).

As part of the auction process (inspecting auction material and/or attending the auction) the following will be required:

- **Site Access:** All personnel receiving access to the site, to attend the pre-sale inspection and/or auction, shall be required to sign a Centrus Energy Corp. Auction Bidder's Statement (Individual) or Centrus Energy Corp. Auction Bidder's Statement (Company Representative). These documents will be available at the registration table, and must be signed prior to entry for inspection. *Personnel unwilling or unable to sign shall not be granted authorization for entry and will be asked to leave the property.*
- **Successful Bidders:** All successful bidders on lots subject to export or commerce controls shall be required to sign a Buyer's Statement containing supplemental terms and conditions. Material will not be released to the purchaser without the Seller's receipt of this form.
- **Inspection of Mori Seiki, Kellenberger, and HAAS** manufacturing machines will be by appointment only on November 6-7 2017. General access to the site will be per instructions listed above. Additional procedures and controls are required for viewing these machines.
- **While on site:**
  - **Absolutely no firearms, ammunition, explosives, or alcoholic beverages are allowed on site.**
  - **All vehicles and persons are subject to search at the discretion of site security personnel.**
